



Aurora Country Club 2024 Caddie Program



Thank you for your interest in the Caddie Program at the Aurora Country Club. In this packet you will find a Caddie Application, Caddie Rules and Tips for being an exceptional Caddie. If you are interested in becoming a Caddie, you must be at least 14 years of age, return the enclosed Caddie Application by March 29th and be available for training April 9th & 10th and April 16th & 17th and April 23rd & 24th. All new caddies are required to attend (3) minimum training sessions before they will be allowed to caddie. Once new caddies have completed the on-course training, they will be required to take a written test. As soon as the applicant has scored a passing grade on the written test, he/she will be allowed to start caddying on-course with the membership. (1st loop each new caddy to the program will be required to shadow an “Honor” caddy)

Caddie Rules:

1. Caddies are independent contractors of the player and are not Club Employees.
2. All caddies must be at least 14 years of age.
3. Caddies are not allowed to arrive at the Club prior to 6:30 a.m. unless requested by the Head Golf Professional, Assistant Golf Professional or Caddie Master.
4. Once you arrive at the Club, please sign with the Caddie Master.
5. If you ride your bicycle to the Club, please park your bicycle in the designated areas. Please lock your bicycle as the Club is not responsible for any personal property of the caddie's that is left unattended.
6. The use of profane or insulting language is prohibited.
7. Any form of tobacco, drugs and alcohol is prohibited.
8. No card playing or gambling is permitted while at the Club.
9. Caddies are to remain in the Caddie Shack at all times unless they have been assigned a player.
10. Caddies must present a neat and clean appearance and follow the caddie dress code of khaki shorts or pants, a solid white golf shirt, and a Blue or White caddie bib supplied by the club.
11. All new caddies are required to pay the \$20.00 new caddie fee to cover expenses associated to hire and train them.
12. Fighting and horse play is prohibited.
13. All players will be addressed as Mr., Mrs. or Dr.
14. Caddies are required to return all clubs to the bagroom after the round cleaned.
15. Caddies are required to keep the Caddie Shack clean. Littering is prohibited.
16. Caddies are not to swing player's clubs or hit any shots on the course.
17. Caddies are prohibited from riding on the back of the golf cars.

Caddie Rates:

Honor Caddies...\$50.00 "A" Caddies...\$40.00 "B" Caddies...\$30.00

Caddies will receive additional gratuities based on performance. Gratuities are earned, not guaranteed and are at the discretion of the player.

Caddies will be paid in cash by the player or will receive a caddie chit to be turned in for cash. Only chits signed and numbered by the player will be paid. Any caddie trying to get paid twice will be terminated immediately.

If at any time you feel you have been treated unfairly, please request to speak with the Head Golf Professional. He will examine the situation and do his best to correct it.
